The Multicultural Network is a group representing Michigan's major ethnic minority groups. The Chicano/Latino, African American, Asian American, Arab American and Native American population groups are represented. Each agency participating in the Network has information and expertise regarding tobacco as it affects their population. These agencies are available to provide general resource information about their population in Michigan, and answer questions that you may encounter.
